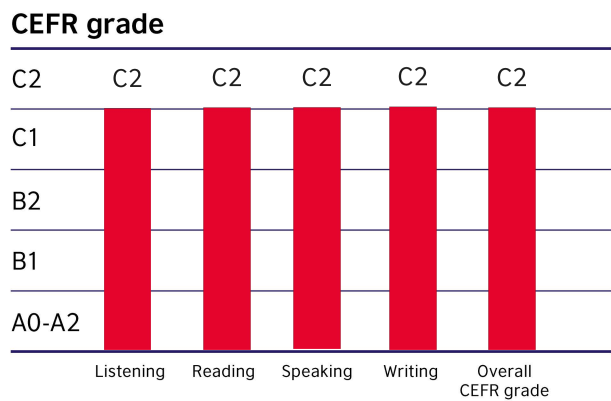

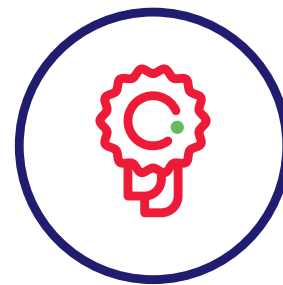

Listening
